Year 3 Wellbeing Curriculum: Understanding your Brain

Outcomes for Pupils as a result of this module:

To understand how their brain works and how their brain can influence thinking and behaviour.

Knowledge

- o To describe the brain as divided into two hemispheres.
- o To locate the left hemisphere and right hemisphere modalities.
- To define the difference between the left hemisphere modality and the right hemisphere modality.
- o To describe the brain as having an upstairs and a downstairs.
- o To locate the parts of the brain using a model brain.
- o To define the difference between the upstairs and downstairs brain.

Skills

- o To develop the appropriate use of scientific terms related to the brain.
- o To manipulate and construct a model brain with a learning partner.
- o To design their own brain and produce an information page and/or leaflet to show their knowledge.
- o To manipulate and construct a model brain with a learning partner.
- To design either:
 - 1. 'Amygdala Hi Jack' Poster to describe the process.
 - 2. An 'Upstairs Vs Downstairs' Brain Poster to describe the functions of these parts of the brain.

- o To demonstrate their knowledge of left hemisphere and right hemisphere modalities in applying the strategy 'Name it to Tame it' in school and home life.
- o To explain the difference between the upstairs and downstairs brain.
